#### What is an LMS?



- A **learning management system (LMS)** is a <u>software application</u> for the administration, documentation, tracking, reporting and delivery of education courses or training programs. [1]
- LMSs range from systems for managing training and educational records to software for distributing <u>online</u> or blended/hybrid college courses over the Internet with features for online collaboration. Colleges and universities use LMSs to deliver online courses and augment on-campus courses. Corporate training departments use LMSs to deliver online training as automate record-keeping and employee registration.
